#### XLIV Children's Fiction Award 2025 Guillem Cifré de Colonya

The writer and puppeteer Xavier Margenat has been awarded with the XLIV Guillem Cifré de Colonya Children's and Young Adult's Fiction Award 2025 for his work *Nils, don't be afraid*. The Guillem Cifré de Colonya Children's and Young Adult's Fiction Award are sponsored by the Guillem Cifré de Colonya Foundation and has the support of Editorial Barcanova, which publishes the winning works. The award rewards novels in Catalan aimed at readers from 8 to 14 years old.

**Xavier Margenat Godoy** was born in Girona in 1964. He is a computer programmer and has worked for many years in a bank. He writes novels for children and young adults and performs puppet and ventriloquism shows with the aim of promoting literature among children. He is a Red Cross volunteer in the play center of the Josep Trueta hospital, where his puppets distract and cheer up the hospitalized children. Furthermore, he has completed several fiction workshops at the Writing School of the Ateneu Barcelonès and in 2020 he received the Montserrat Roig Writing Scholarship. He has published novels for children and young adults such as *Ter's Treasure* (2006, CCG Edicions), *The Drums Boy* (2018, Curbet Edicions) and *Saint George and the Book Eater Dragon* (Editorial el Pirata, 2020). He also is part of the program of the Generalitat de Catalunya "Authors in the Classrooms".

Nils, don't be afraid is the story of Nils, a small, rat-faced boy with thirteen phobias who suffers from bullying. He will become friends with Oriol, a boy who loves mysteries and who will invite him to visit the ruins of the old casino of Arrabassada. There they will witness a crime but, when they report it, the police will not listen to them. Nils and Oriol will investigate the clues of the crime, and this will lead them to live a kind of *escape room* for the most sinister places in Barcelona in search of a legendary treasure. Throughout the adventure, Nils will have to face his fears.

With this work, Margenat presents a dynamic thriller full of humor with a protagonist with whom current readers will easily identify. With a clear and direct style and inviting the reader to let their imagination run wild, the work naturally deals with bullying and difficulties in socializing. Friendship and self-improvement also play a key role.

Since its first edition in 1981, the Guillem Cifré de Colonya Award has supported children's and young adult's literature in Catalan and has published more than forty works by authors such as Joaquim Carbó, Josep Francesc Delgado, Lolita Bosch, Rosa Maria Colom, Pere Rosselló, Miquel Ferrà, Pere Morey, Miquel Rayó, Montse Homs, Mariona Bessa and Carlota Gurt. Most of these works have become common reading for younger readers and have also been part of the selection of books with which schools teach and spread Catalan language and culture.

#### About the author

Beatriz Bernal was a writer of the Spanish Golden Age, born in Valladolid and considered the first novelist of Spanish literature. She is the author of "Cristalián de España" (1545), the first novel of chivalry romance published by a woman in Spain, initially anonymously. Widowed on two occasions, she lived in a literate environment, which favored her training and access to books. Her work stands out for giving greater prominence to female characters in a traditionally male gender. After her death, her daughter Juana de Gatos managed to republish the novel in 1586 under the author's name, consolidating her legacy. Bernal left a valuable library and is considered a key figure in the history of Hispanic literature.






## THE CAMDEN TOWN REBELS






## Where Flowers Don't Die II Fandom Prize


