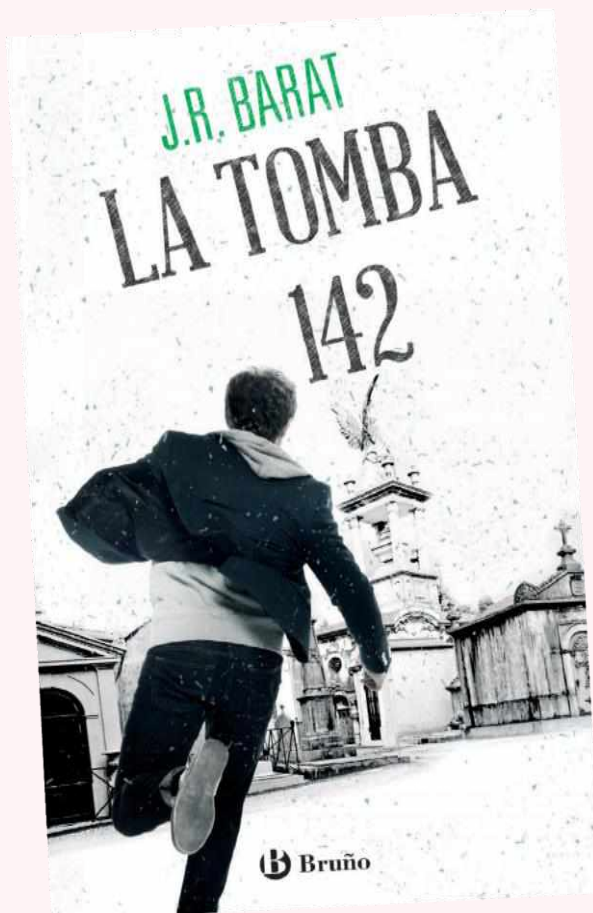
Fernando Lalana is an award-winning writer of children's and young adults literature. Winner of the National Prize for Literature, He has published more than a hundred works.
