
A world history through the prism of numismatics with 19 illustrations of different currencies tips for junior numismatists!

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
Throughout history, women have been hired to cry at wakes and funerals. It is an ancient practice in which the mourners became tragic actresses, publicly displaying the grief of the deceased's relatives.

The popular belief was that the mourners' crying helped to purge the soul of the dead, facilitating their entry into paradise, although the Catholic Church considered it a pagan and superstitious act. In the coal-mining culture of Lota, women took turns standing next to the coffin, because most of the time they had to attend to the mourners.


A witty and striking visual narrative about a beetroot like no other — impossible to ignore, yet open to interpretation!


The 20 illustrations (including front and back cover) that accompany the original text, visually underline key scenes and concepts of the book. Following Kafka's stated wishes in a letter to his editor, the illustrations never clearly depict the insect, leaving us to imagine it. Pencil drawings are combined with watercolour effects that add visual chaos and uncertainty. Instead of exposing what the text describes, the illustrations focus on the text's underlying themes, a conceptual visual commentary. Printed in two spot colors (green and bordeaux) the story of *The Metamorphosis* can be seen in a new yet faithful way, alongside the timeless words of Franz Kafka.
