
Music and Globalization






Modern art from the Nordic countries Norway, Sweden, Denmark, Finland, and Iceland tends to be represented by a few famous artists, and an aesthetic known for combining originality and continuity of tradition. Nevertheless, the region is far from homogeneous. Each country has its own artistic language, culture and history, sometimes co-existing with its neighbours in harmony, sometimes engaging them in hard-fought conflict.


This extensively illustrated survey offers a new history of Nordic art, from the emergence of Impressionism in the 1870s, through the avant-garde experiments of the early decades of the 20th century and onward to the Second World War and beyond. A broad range of artists are featured, some familiar and others less renowned: Anders Zorn and Hilma af Klint, Vilhelm Hammershøi and Franciska Clausen, Edvard Munch and Harriet Backer, Akseli Gallen-Kallela and Fanny Churberg, Finnur Jónsson and Öyvind Fahlström. Each artist's work is vividly placed in the context of their homeland as well as the international art movements of the time. The significant role of women artists is also showcased, chronicling their artistic legacy as well as their broader social contributions. The result is a comprehensive account of modern Nordic art in one impressive volume that is sure to become a definitive history.

Serge Fauchereau, after teaching American Literature at New-York University and in Texas, worked for ten years at the Pompidou Center as a curator of major exhibitions (*Paris-New York, Paris-Berlin, Paris-Moscou, Les Réalismes*, etc.). He has published over twenty works including a dozen monographs such as: *Braque, Jean Arp, Kupka, Malevitch*, etc. His works published with Flammarion include *Avant-gardes du XX*° siècle (2010), *Le Cubisme* (2012), *Les Peintres Mexicains 1910-1960* (2013) and *L'Art des pays baltes* (2021)

A former student of the École Normale Supérieure and former resident at the Villa Medicis, he is a member of the LIRA research centre. His work explores the intersections between art, politics, and contemporary social issues.

Daring the Nude

The Nude Represented by Women Artists

Books are increasingly tackling the "gender" stereotypes in art history, emphasizing the "male gaze" in the depiction of women. In contrast, the "female gaze" theory, which emerged in the mid-1970s with feminist art history, remains underexplored, especially regarding how female artists portray the nude.

Historically, women lacked access to nude classes and were hesitant to participate. But perhaps the real issue is our collective inability to see the nude through women's eyes.

This work aims to flip the script on art history and open our eyes to the female gaze, spanning four centuries with chronological chapters featuring artists born from 1575 to 1975:

Hildegard von Bingen, Artemisia Gentileschi, Imogen Cunnigham, Paula Modersohn-Becker, Suzanne Valadon, Amrita Sher-Gil, Tarsila do Amaral, Faith Ringgold, Martha Rosler, Cindy Sherman, Louise Bourgeois, Alice Neel are some of the many artists to have represented the naked body in their time.

Camille Morineau is a French exhibition curator, heritage curator and artistic director. For ten years she worked at the Musée National d'Art Moderne in the Centre National d'Art et de Culture Georges-Pompidou in curating the exhibition elles@ centrepompidou. From 2016 to 2019, she was Director of Collections and Exhibitions at the Monnaie de Paris. In November 2020, she was appointed Chair of the Board of Directors of the École du Louvre. She is also the founder of AWARE (Archives of Women Artists, Research and Exhibitions), an organization dedicated to raising the visibility of women artists from the 20th century onward.



From the 19th century onwards, many women took up photography, which was still in its infancy. Present in every field right up to the present day, from art to journalism, fashion, science and advertising, they all too often come up against a lack of recognition and visibility.

Laure Adler puts them in the spotlight with a selection of her personal choices, bringing together pioneers, forgotten figures and young discoveries. Some are involved in politics or feminist activism, others venture into war zones or break with norms and conventions. All take risks, break free from established frameworks and invent new forms, new ways of being and working. These women challenge the expectations and assumptions surrounding their profession and status.

Laure Adler is a journalist, writer and historian, specialized in women studies and feminism during the nineteenth and twentieth centuries. She contributed to *Dangerous Women: The Perils of Muses and Femmes Fatales* (Flammarion, 2010) and authored numerous essays and books including *Marguerite Duras: A Life* (Phoenix, 2001), whose French edition was awarded the Prix Femina.







Barbara Cassin, philosopher and hellenist, is a specialist in Greek philosophers and rhetoric. A research director at the National Centre for Scientific Research, she was elected to the French Academy in 2018. Her work focuses on sophistry, rhetoric, and their relationship with philosophy.

This first monograph of work by architect Tatsuro Miki reflects his singular talent for designing spaces that embody subtle beauty, harmony, and proportion in close kinship with nature.

Koen Van Synghel is an architect as well as an art and architecture critic.

Axel Vervoordt is a Belgian art collector, antiques dealer, interior designer, curator, and author of numerous books, including *Wabi Inspirations*.

A compelling graphic novel about one of the most intriguing figures of the 18th century in Europe. Charles de Beaumont, alias Chevalier d'Éon, also known as Chevalière d'Éon is considered to be one of the first spies in history, operating under the direct orders of King Louis XV. Until his death, he fooled an entire kingdom by keeping the mystery of his true identity: was he a man or a woman?

It was at Versailles that Charles de Beaumont first drew attention to himself. Invited to a fancy-dress ball by the Countess of Rochefort, he appeared dressed as a woman. His disguise was so convincing that Prince de Conti decided to enlist him into the "Secret du Roi," the covert intelligence network of King Louis XV, one of the first intelligence services in history. At war with England, Louis XV sought to infiltrate the highest levels of enemy power. During his first mission in Russia, Charles de Beaumont displayed remarkable skill by alternating between two very different personas: Chevalier Beaumont and his sister Lia de Beaumont, who joined Empress Elizabeth I of Russia's court as a reader. These two characters ultimately facilitated the alliance between Russia and France against the English and the Prussians. He was then sent to England by the king to gather intelligence on the British coastline in preparation for a potential French invasion. But d'Éon, holding sensitive information, lost the king's trust and used female disguise to protect himself. Charles de Beaumont was allowed to return to France on the condition of wearing women's clothing for life.

The graphic novel uses a Paris theatre after the French Revolution as a set to tell his story, and is followed by a historical appendix that contextualizes the characters and events, drawing on documents from the French diplomatic archives.

Damien MacDonald is a comic book illustrator and curator who published a graphic novel adaptation of Victor Hugo's *The Hunchback of Notre-Dame* and *Anatomy of Comics*. His work has been shown in museums and galleries in France, Norway, Belgium, China, and Monaco. He co-curated the Marginalia exhibition *Inside The Comics Art Collections* for the Nouveau Musée National de Monaco.


