
Each plant has its own secret, a unique strategy for survival in a hostile environment: the Soldanelle, capable of starting to grow under the snow and then melting it like a radiator; the Saxifrage, endowed with miraculously detoxifying properties; the Mouse-tails as old as the mammoths; the giant senna, a colossal elephant's foot endemic to the slopes of Kilimanjaro; the Andean Llaretas, huge mounds of hummocky moss, vegetable coral spuds sometimes three thousand years old, so full of resin that people scalp them to make fire.
