Welcome to our Spring Guide showcasing the best of our publishing this season. Our titles are now represented across three guides, to help save you time, so please do look out for our non-fiction and Priddy Books Rights catalogues too.

Starting with our very youngest readers, I want to highlight our new character-led board book series, Matty and Mo by Rosalind Beardshaw. The series is already attracting a great deal of attention; we go to Bologna with six languages confirmed, with more to come. Camilla Reid's Macmillan Children's Books publishing has had a brilliant first year and there are now more than a quarter of a million copies of her books in print around the world. Her new series is illustrated by awardwinning Kate Hindley and introduces best friends Nell and Beany, who are at the very centre of their adventures, as all toddlers are. This novelty series is perfect for sharing, and inspiring creative play.

Emily Gravett won the Macmillan Prize for Illustration twenty-one years ago and we are proud to have been her publishing home ever since. Her new picture book, *Bear's Nap*, is a classic in the making; full of her signature humour and engaging animals characters. The 'Mac Prize' continues to discover brilliant new talent and we have new picture books from Becky Colvin with *The Great Green Island* and Kate Rolfe with *Owl and Moon*.

Highlights on our picture book list include Diane Ewen's *The Great Unicorn Escape*, this is the second picture book in the Unicorn Forest series and is a great adventure about finding friends in unexpected places, and Julia Donaldson's *Gozzle* is the latest joyful picture book illustrated by Sara Ogilvie. Publishing this spring, it is backed by an extensive marketing campaign, and we are very pleased to have eight publishers already signed up to be part of this growing partnership brand.

Illustration remains central to our young fiction lists. The Mubbles by Liz Pichon is ready to find its fans this year as children around the world discover this brilliant and hilarious new world of crazy characters. In middle-grade, look out for Rob Biddulph's exciting new adventure series The Moonhaven Chronicles, C.M Lewis's epic fantasy Quill and the Last Generation, hilarious debut Dante N Ferno is NOT a Loser by Brian Gordon and laugh-out-loud colour graphic novel Tiny Hercules by Jon Lock and Nich Angell.

Our YA imprint, First Ink, goes from strength to strength. After Frankfurt, we had a flurry of pre-empts, offers and auctions in nine territories for *The Sleepless* by Jen Williams. *Of Flame and Fury* by Mikayla Bridge has been snapped up in four languages so far, and the compelling gothic fantasy romance *Like the Moon We Rise* by Annabelle Cormack is the latest addition to this hugely exciting list.

We have been publishing books to entertain children since Macmillan released *Alice's Adventures in Wonderland* by Lewis Carroll 160 years ago in 1865. It is our ambition to keep doing so for many years to come and we look forward to working with you to inspire the young readers of the future.


