
Thanks to ironic illustrations, and clear and rigorous contents reviewed by a marine biologist, the theory about the selection and the evolution of species won't have any secrets!





Marguerite Claudia 'Meta' Brevoort was one of the first female mountaineers in history. Born in New York in 1825, she began mountaineering at the age of 40, when she moved to Switzerland with her nephew William Auguste Coolidge. *An Uphill Dream* doesn't deal with the strictly mountaineering aspect of this courageous woman's life, but focuses on a bizarre anecdote that makes one 'laugh and cry' at the same time.

In 1875, Marguerite, William and their dog dog Tschingel climbed Mont Blanc, the highest of all the Alps. It was not the first human ascent, but it was the first canine ascent. The event generated so much astonishment that, the same year, the dog was elected honorary member of the famous Alpine Club of London, the first association of mountain men. Marguerite also aspired to be a member, given her mountaineering achievements, but she was turned down because women were not allowed in that group. Meta commented on this fact in a letter to her sister, writing that Tschingel was the first lady ever to be admitted into that exclusive association!

His books are translated in 18 countries in the world.

In 2017, he won the Italian Andersen Prize and in the same year he was selected for the IBBY International Collection of Outstanding Books for Young People with Disabilities. In 2020 he entered in the White Ravens international selection with the book *Black boys*.

GIACOMO A. MODICA is born in 1995, he is an illustrator. His first book was published by the Italian publisher UovoNero.

Mocha Dick was a male sperm whale that lived in the Pacific Ocean in the early 19th century, usually encountered in the waters near Mocha island, off the central coast of Chile. It was large and powerful, capable of wrecking small craft with his fluke. It has been fighting against the whalers for over thirty years, putting up a desperate resistance. Its prodigious size and strength inspired legends and novels, including the most famous one by Herman Melville, *Moby*

In this original and powerful picture book, it is recounted the merciless struggle between the huge white sperm whale, Mocha Dick, and the whalers over the course of decades. The events have been reconstructed through the memories of sailors who took part in the struggle and noted the events in their logbooks. The author gives also voice to those whom strenuously opposed this ruthless hunt, becoming a myth: the great white sperm whale Mocha Dick.




FRANCESCO CORTONESI is a writer, a teacher, and an environmental activist.

Beastian tells the story of Sebastiano, called Bastian first and Beastian later. A taciturn boy with special needs and, fortunately, a welcoming and loving family. Beastian only draws animals. Lots of animals. And not only that: he seems to have a special relationship with animals, almost as if he were talking to them. And then those little hairs on his back, those slightly feral physical features....

A science-fiction story for children, which talks about very strange things such as the recombination of human-animal DNA, but it does so in a language - Bruno Tognolini's typical language - that makes everything clear, that goes straight to the heart with its poetry. The work reflects the author's personal **love for the animal world**, but above all an invitation: **to go beyond appearances**, to have **respect for our surroundings**, to have regard for those people who seem so very different from us.

Universal messages, in this transformer tale - again, stealing Tognolini's words - that starts out as a slice of life of a special child and turns, almost without realising it, into a cyberpunk and biofantasy work.



THE AUTHOR. Bruno Tognolini is one of the most well-reputed Italian authors in Italy and abroad. Born in Cagliari, he lives in Bologna, in Lecce, and on the road in a thousand meetings with readers. He has written poetry, novels and short stories in over 60 titles. He is the author of theatre texts, articles, songs, television programmes. He has won numerous awards, most recently the Pierluigi Cappello Prize in 2022.

THE ILLUSTRATOR. Alicia Baladan was born in Uruguay where she spent her childhood. She moved to Italy and graduated from the Brera Academy of Fine Arts in Milan. She worked in animation cinema and contemporary art, and in recent years has concentrated on illustration, writing and education. Today she lives and works in Brescia.
