In short, plastic expression is necessary for the development of children. They only need encouragement so that they start to explore the working materials, giving free rein to their imagination.

We all have the ability to be creative, and it is a skill that can be developed through the plastic arts. Starting with a pencil and advancing through different ways to draw and paint, images explain more techniques step by step. Real examples made by children will motivate other kids and will release their undiscovered creativity from within.
