



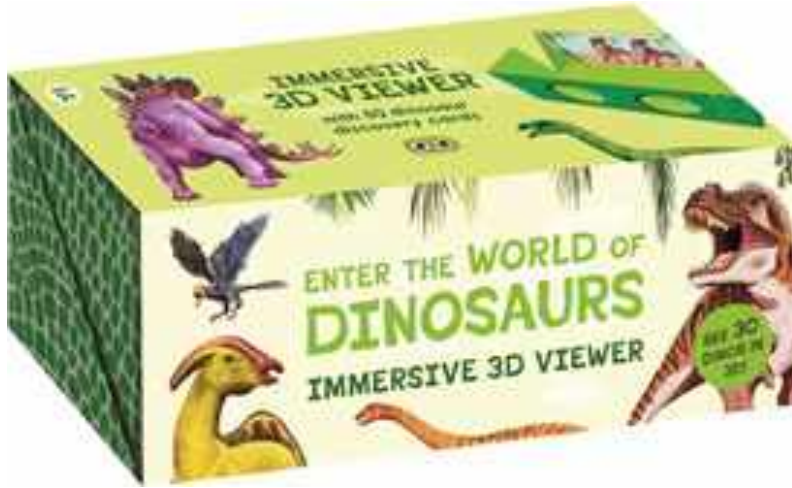

Triceratops lived at the same time as Tyrannosaurus and would have had to defend itself so it didn't get eaten.

In fact, scientists found part of a fossil Triceratops skull with a T.rex-sized bite taken out of one horn! BUILD A ROBOT

Robots are the ultimate electrical machines. Some electronic engineers spend years designing and building different robots. In this awesome activity you can try it yourself and create a robot that actually lights up. You're sure to take it home to this deal!

What you need:
Card pieces 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10 (see sheet)
Copper tape
Two LEDs
100µV pack (see sheet)
100µV pack (see sheet)

- 1 Carefully cut strips of copper tape to fit the grey box and one piece 1, 2, three per card piece in place. Make sure it fits over the gaps in the circuit.
- 2 Push the LEDs through the top holes in card piece 20, on either robot.
- 3 Slide card pieces 6 and 7 into the bottom of card piece 5 (the robot's body). Then slide card pieces 8 and 9 (the legs) into the bottom of the top.
- 4 Take your conductive circuit board piece 10, and slot the LEDs through the eye holes in the robot. Use sticky tape to secure it in place.

REMEMBER!
LEDs have a positive (+) side and a negative (-) side. The longer leg on an LED is positive and the shorter leg is negative. Make sure the positive side of the battery is wired to the positive side of an LED.

A LITTLE LIGHT RELIEF

Every evening, billions of people around the world switch on light bulbs. Light bulbs turn electricity into light (and heat). We take them for granted, but 200 years ago light bulbs didn't exist. So how did people live without them?

IF IN THE DARK
Before the Victorian times, people used candles or oil lamps to light their homes. It was hard to see much other than on these light sources, and it was very messy.

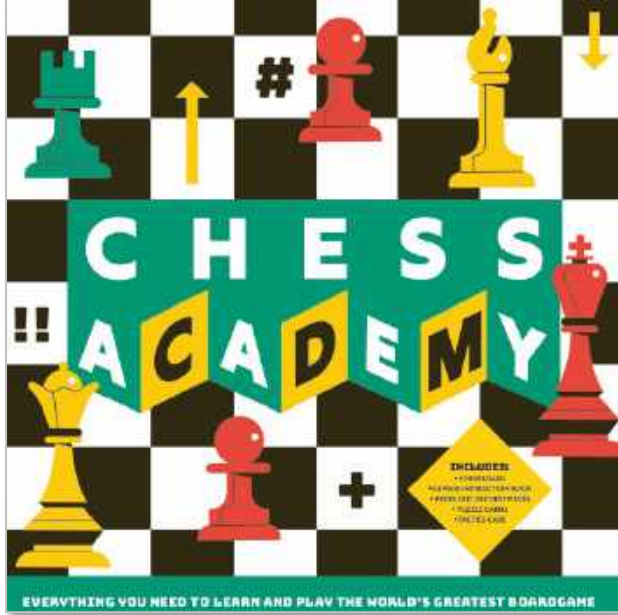
INCREDIBLE EDISON
Thomas Edison (1847-1931) was a US inventor and businessman. He was the first person to create a working light bulb, but he was not the first person to develop a complete light and electrical system with wires and power stations. That was the job of Nikola Tesla, who developed more than 3,000 inventions - now taking a type of electric car.

DO YOU KNOW?
Edison tested thousands of materials for light bulb filaments, including human hair. He also discovered that a thin filament of carbonized paper worked better than a thicker one.

TRY IT YOURSELF
If you have a light bulb, you can try to make one. You can use a small piece of wire to make a filament. The filament is the part that glows when you turn on the light. You can also try to make a light bulb that uses a different material for the filament.
