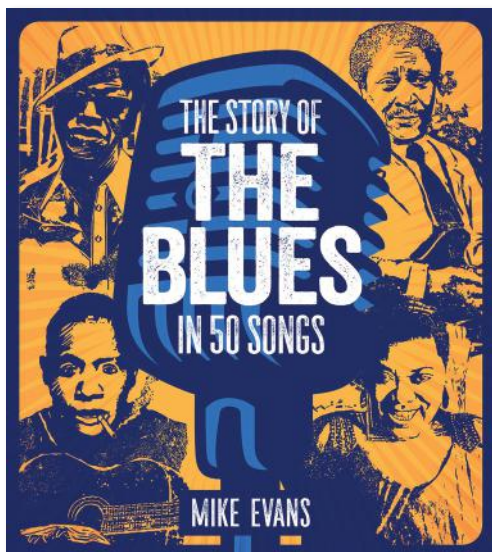
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The Story of the Blues in 50 Songs

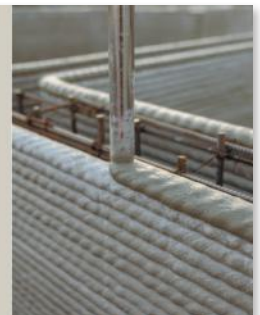


3D PRINTING

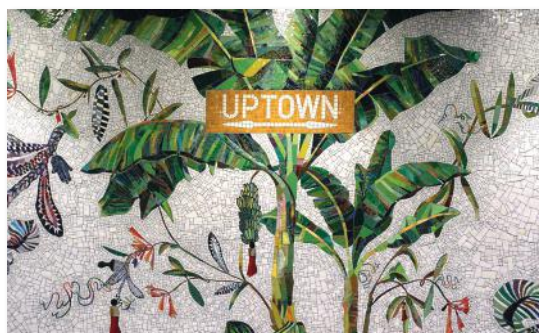
This art book explores the artwork of a select group of 10 artists with work commissioned by the New York MTA Arts & Design Program.
