An exceptional and amazing novelty book to enjoy the bedtime story in a different way and let yourself be gently carried off to sleep, because, for once, the light will be switched off!

The story that will thus come to life is a universally known and loved tale, *The Three Little Pigs*, for the pleasure of rediscovering a familiar universe in a different reading experience. The parent lights the torch on their smartphone, which they insert into a wedge. In the darkened room, the laser-cut images are projected on the ceiling, like a shadow theater, and the reading flows smoothly, with no other manipulation than simple leafing.

A mode of reading as innovative as the process is old, that of the art of Chinese shadow theatre, which allows the child to find the ideal conditions to fall asleep softly - already in a lying position, without light, lulled by the rhythm specific to the tale that plays on repetition and variation -, and which will lead him to independent reading in a fun way.

Let yourself be won over by the magic of shadow games! This is the book that will convince children to turn off the lights, go to bed and stay in it!

## A picture book full of humour to prove once and for all that diversity is in nature!




To answer their questions, Léna invites them to close their eyes and takes them to discover the richness of the living world, from the first notions of evolution to the classification of species (vertebrates, mammals...). She ends with the (numerous!) similarities between the human being and the other animals.

At the end of the tale, the children reopen their eyes and come back to the opening scene.

To make the reading interactive and playful, the tale is interspersed with small activities proposed by the hummingbird.

After *Take me to the origins of our universe*, this book is the second title of the series. It is inspired by the permanent exhibition at the very attractive Musée des Confluences in Lyon (700,000 visitors/year), France, with which we collaborate.
