L. "Lyman" Frank Baum was an American author and writer of children's books. He was born in Chittenango, New York, in 1856. Baum started writing at an early age; throughout his prolific career, he penned over fifty novels, eighty short stories, and two hundred poems. In 1900, Baum wrote his most successful work, *The Wonderful Wizard of Oz*, which he shared the copyright for with illustrator W. W. Denslow. The book quickly became a bestseller, and has inspired dozens of popular theater and film adaptations ever since.

John R. Neill was an American illustrator for newspapers and children's books. He is primarily known for illustrating the Oz books by L. Frank Baum, beginning with the second book of the series, *The Marvelous Land of Oz*. Robert Louis Stevenson was a Scottish novelist, poet, essayist, musician and travel writer. His most famous works are *Treasure Island*, *Kidnapped*, *Strange Case of Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde*, and *A Child's Garden of Verses*. Stevenson was a literary celebrity during his lifetime, and now ranks as the twenty-sixth most translated author in the world.

Charles Robinson was a prolific book illustrator. The first full book he illustrated was Robert Louis Stevenson's *A Child's Garden of Verses* (1895) which includes over one hundred pen and ink drawings. It was extremely popular, going through many reprints, and generated numerous commissions. 

All this is preceded by an original introduction of more than 150 pages. This classic material combined with a brand-new foreword by Dr. Foy Scalf of Chicago University gives the reader has a unique opportunity to experience all the fascinating aspects of *The Egyptian Book of the Dead*.


Dr. E. A. Wallis Budge is known as being one of the most renowned Egyptologists in the world. After discovering the Papyrus of Ani in 1888, he became the Assistant Keeper and eventually the Keeper of Oriental Antiquities at the British Museum. Though his career was controversial, he brought many tablets, manuscripts, and other findings from his multiple trips to Egypt and the Sudan back to the museum. In 1920, he was knighted for his service to Egyptology and the British Museum. He died in London in 1934 at the age of seventy-seven.

Foy Scalf studied Egyptology at the University of Chicago where he wrote a dissertation on Demotic funerary papyri dating from 1st–2nd century CE Egypt. His published work covers a variety of topics including Egyptian grammar, philology, Demotic texts, magic, and religion. He was awarded the Archival Innovator award from the Society of American Archivists in 2016. In 2017, he curated the Oriental Institute special exhibit Book of the Dead: Becoming God in Ancient Egypt and edited the accompanying catalog.

Cornelia Meigs was an American writer of children's fiction and nonfiction. She wrote dozens of books, both fiction and nonfiction. *Kirkus Reviews* called her "one of the best-loved authors of fiction for boys and girls." Some of her more notable works include her Louisa May Alcott biography and Newberry Medal winner, *Invincible Louisa* (1933), and three Newberry Honor award winners: *Windy Hill* (1922), *Clearing Weather* (1928), and *Swift Rivers* (1933).

Berta Hader was born in Mexico in 1890. She moved around the US throughout her childhood, eventually settling in San Francisco where she attended the California School of Design. There she met and befriended Rose Wilder Lane, daughter of then-unknown Laura Ingalls Wilder. It is there she also met her future husband Elmer Hader, with whom she illustrated and co-wrote multiple children's books. In 1918, she moved to New York where she did fashion illustration for *McCall's* magazine and was married a year later.

Elmer Hader was born in California and, at the age of 16 as a part of the National Guard, helped restore balance to San Francisco after the earthquake of 1906. He attended the California School of Design at the same time as his future wife, Betty. In 1918, he was drafted into the US Army and after spending a year in France as a part of the Camouflage Corps, he moved straight to New York City. After being demobilized in 1919, he married Betty.
