School finishes in the middle of the day and as soon as it does, I rush home. Tourists flap under our awning for relief from the high, hot *Solra*. I quickly change out of my school uniform and hang it up ready for tomorrow. I throw on light clothes (much cooler than my itchy uniform) and bustle around collecting cups and bowls to wash. I put some more spices on to steam and prepare another batch of *meatballs*, and before I know it the *Solra* is ending and more tourists arrive.

It's a very dramatic view tonight. Dark grey storm clouds roll over the lake and hills, with radiant orange-yellow sunbeams behind them. The air smells like rain. But the rain holds off until the sky is dark and the tourists have left. That's when we prepare our own evening meal of rice and lentils full of warm spices. While we cook and eat, we tell each other everything we learned today. I try out some new English words and phrases, which *Auntie* repeats.
