


Lina. Avventure di un'architetta

But the coal dealer doesn't hear him: his wife doesn't want him to listen, and tries to convince him that the night is empty and quiet, and there's no one outside. Until the bucket rider, chased away by the woman with her apron, takes his way to the cold mountains.
